



Lana' David Walker

April 10, 1944 - June 1, 2012

The life of Lana' David Walker began April 10, 1944. He is the third of seven sons from the union of the late Rev. Lawrence and Josephine Syas Walker. Pastor Walker was raised by loving, caring and God fearing parents who taught him by example. They also taught him the power of prayer and the joy of serving the Lord. He accepted Christ at an early age at Simmons Chapel Baptist Church. He attended school at Booker T. Washington in Haskell, OK. He moved to California and worked in construction, and later returned to Oklahoma and worked various jobs. After some time he formed his own business where his pride and joy was, doing concrete work and doing it well.

He married Alice Bowers on May 11, 1982 whom he later referred to as "Toots. He was a devoted Christian and husband. Pastor Walker preached his first sermon at Harris Chapel Baptist Church in Lewisville, OK on October 5, 2003. He was ordained September 28, 2008 while under the leadership of Rev. R.C. Triplett of Harris Chapel for several years. He was interim pastor of Greater Mt. Pleasant, Spiro, OK beginning August 31, 2009 and was installed as Pastor November 15, 2009. During this time he became a member of Union Baptist Church, Pocola, OK - Rev. Marvin Thompson. Pastor Walker continued to fulfill his duties until his health began to fail.

Lana' departed this life peacefully on Friday, June 1, 2012 surrounded by his family.
