



Arthur Granvill Scrapper

November 15, 1935 - October 31, 2013

Mr. Arthur Granvill Scrapper, 77, of Stilwell died Thursday, October 31, 2013 in a Stilwell Nursing Home. He was born on November 15, 1935 in Adair to Worth Scrapper and Fannie (Blackburn) Scrapper.
