OBITUARY FOR MR. Barry Dale Hamlin:

Mr. Barry Dale Hamlin, 76, longtime Stigler resident passed away Friday, March 30, 2018 at the Veterans Administration Hospital at Muskogee. He was born May 22, 1941 in Shafter, California to Gilbert and Oleta (Vickers) Hamlin. The family moved back and forth from California to Oklahoma before settling in Haskell County. Barry graduated from Stigler High School with the class of 1959. He joined the United States Air Force soon after and served most of his tour in Germany as Air Police.
