Clarence Leon Calhoun Sr., 84 of Quinton died Friday, January 14, 2022 at his home. He was born March 31, 1937 at Sandridge, Oklahoma to Albert Levi (Tab) Calhoun and Evelyn (Thompson) Calhoun. Clarence joined the United States Navy at age 17 and served 20 years for his country. At age 19 he came home on leave and was married to Charlene Adcock in Stigler on April 14, 1956. He served as a Gunners Mate during two tours of Viet Nam. He was stationed San Diego, CA, Key Port, WA, New Orleans, LA, Albuquerque, NM, and Long Beach, CA.
