Mr. Harry Earl Reeder, 87 of Stigler, passed away Thursday, January 12, 2017 at Haskell County Nursing Center. He was born on March 17, 1929 in Cheraw, Colorado to Harold and Myrtle (Carrington) Reeder. He was the fourth child of eight children. His family moved to Filer, Idaho in the 1930's where his family farmed and where he received his education. When he was sixteen years old his family moved to Albany, Oregon.
