Jack Donald Clay, 70 left this earth on March 18, 2015, to go live in the “Mansion in the sky with no more pain and no more suffering” as he often quoted. Jack was born July 1, 1944 in Riverside, CA to Anna Mae (Ridling) Clay and Troy Clay. Due to a brain injury, he was raised at home by his grandmother, Olivia Ridling. Jack grew up Jehovah Witness, and lived his life by the principals she taught him. He was a kind, gentle, soft spoken, moral and Godly man who was dearly loved. Jack lived most of his life in the Riverside, CA area until moving to Stigler, OK later in life. He was one of the first to move into the new Ki Bois Group Home where he lived about 12 years until moving to Haskell County Nursing Center.

Jack is survived by a half-sister, Grace Uribes and husband Richard of California; one nephew, James Lierle. Jack has several cousins who have been his only extended family for many years, Brenda and Bill Mosley and their family of Denton, TX, Betty Ridling of Sulphur, Wanda Thomasson of Pauls Valley, Loretia Lane of Athens, TN.

Jack was preceded in death by his father, Troy Clay; his mother, Anna Mae Lierle; his grandparents, James and Olivia Ridling; all of his aunts and uncles; and several cousins.

God placed two very special angels in Jack’s life, Barbara Amos and Carol Oldham. They visited when no one else was there, sat up at night with him when he was sick or in the hospital, and gave of themselves to the end of his life far beyond anyone’s expectations.
