



## Jack Earl Coughran

September 25, 1937 - January 24, 2017

Mr. Jack Coughran, age 79, of Tulsa, Oklahoma, passed away Tuesday, January 24, 2017 at his home after a long illness. He was born September 25, 1937 in Porum, Oklahoma to Frank and Bessie (Wood) Coughran, the fourth of five sons. He grew up in Porum.

As a young man in the 1950's, Jack volunteered and served a term in the United States Navy, where he was assigned to an Aircraft Carrier, the Franklin D. Roosevelt CVA-42. He fueled some of the first jet airplanes and went through the Shell-Vac Ceremony.

After returning from the Navy in the late '50's, Jack married a Porum girl, Louise Goodner. They moved to Tulsa, Oklahoma where Jack worked as a Wheel Alignment Mechanic. Later on, he owned his own shop. He enjoyed car racing, hunting, and spending time with his family.

Jack is survived by his son, Jack David; his grandson, Joshua; three brothers, Bill and wife Pat of Talala, OK., Bob and wife Frances of Porum, OK., and Lonzo of Muskogee, OK.; several nieces and nephews.
