



Jack Dustin "Dusty" Warren

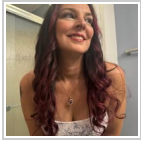
May 1, 1972 - July 1, 2016

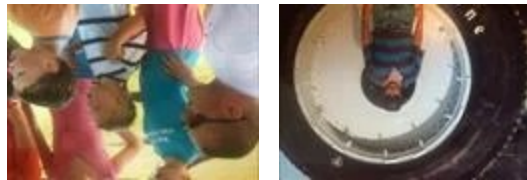
