Jim Bob Kirk, 73, lifelong Stigler resident passed away on Monday, April 28, 2025 at his home. He was born in Fort Smith on April 24, 1952 to Theron "Doc" and Gladys (Day) Kirk. He attended Stigler Public Schools and was a graduate with the class of 1970. He attended Northeastern State University. He was married to Sheryl Lynn Morris on June 13, 1975 and made their home together. He began working for his dad at Doc Kirk furniture for several years. He later worked as a mechanic for Cookson Hills Electric Coop. He was a longtime owner/operator for Kirk Trucking. He finished his working career for the City of Stigler after many years. He surrendered to preach the Gospel in the Baptist Church, he pastored churches at Whitefield, Antioch, and Journey Church, as well as many other churches as he was called. Jim Bob dedicated much of his later life to preaching the Gospel and spreading the Word of God. He also spent much of his time entering the prison ministry which he was passionate about. He spent most of his life caring for others.

He is survived by his wife of nearly 50 years, Sheryl Kirk of the home; his sons, James Kirk and wife Jennifer of Choctaw, Kevin Kirk and wife Elizabeth as well as their children, Ryan and Andrew Kirk of Harrah; two brothers, Joe Bob Kirk and Susan of Owasso, Steven Kirk and wife Debbie of Spiro; numerous nieces and nephews. He is preceded in death by his parents, Theron "Doc" and Gladys Kirk.
