Jim Wimberly, 78, lifelong Lona Valley resident passed away Monday, March 7, 2022 at his home. He was born in Quinton on October 29, 1943 to Doyle and Ruth (Hughart) Wimberly. 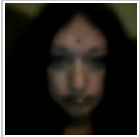
