



## Junior J. Garrett

Reverend Junior J. Garrett, 83, of Stigler, passed away Wednesday, November 8, 2017 at St. John Hospital in Tulsa. He was born April 14, 1934 at McCurtain, Oklahoma to Andrew Jackson and Minnie (McMahan) Garrett. He grew up in the Rocky Ridge Community. He attended Stigler Schools and graduated with the Class of 1951. Junior continued his education at OSU. He married Marie Treadway on September 5, 1951 at Ozark, Arkansas and made their home on Beaver Mountain. He began working for the Army Ammunition Plant in McAlester and later at the Lexington Prison as a Welding Instructor.
