Mr. Lloyd Dean Dowdy, 67, of Stigler died Tuesday, April 29, 2014 at a Fort Smith hospital. He was born December 16, 1946 in Checotah to Lloyd A Dowdy and Fern (Williams) Dowdy. He graduated from Checotah High School in 1965 and also went to Connors for a year.
