



## Myrtle Norvell Whitehead

October 14, 1915 - June 22, 2013

Myrtle Norvell Whitehead, 97 lifelong Kinta resident was called away Saturday, June 22, 2013. She was born October 14, 1915 at Harrison, Arkansas to Allie and Vinnie (Groover) Norvell. She moved with her family from Arkansas at a young age and settled east of Kinta on Sans Bois Creek where the family farmed and ranched. She was educated at Kinta Public Schools through the 8th grade. She was married to Raymond Whitehead on May 27, 1936 and made their home together at Kinta for the next 65 years. Her occupation was that of a homemaker, mother and grandmother.

She wrote articles for the Stigler News Sentinel, the McAlester New Capital and Democrat as well as the Quinton Times. She was a member of the Kinta First Christian Church where she served as a Sunday School teacher and assistant Church Treasurer.
