Sandra K. King "Granny" 81, passed away Monday, October 28, 2024 at Muskogee. She was born at Concord, California to Morris and Geneva (Mileham) Spessard. She grew up in Concord and graduated with the Mount Diablo High School class of '61. She was married to a boy from Rose Hill, Oklahoma named Wayne King on July 1, 1961 and made their home together. In 1972 they packed two kids, a bonus kid, three horses and everything else they owned into a station wagon and a one ton flatbed truck and began a weeklong journey to Oklahoma.
