Obituary for Scotty Dean Webster:

Scotty Dean Webster, 44 of Whitefield, passed away Friday, March 21, 2014 at Stigler Haskell County Hospital. He was born April 8, 1969 in Muskogee to Dean Webster and Fern (Duke) Webster. Scotty graduated from Stigler High School in 1987; in that same year he went to work for ICO in Tulsa as an electrician, until 1991, when an accident left him paralyzed. He enrolled at Kiamichi Area Vo-tech and earned a degree in Computer Programming. Determined to help himself and others, he started his own computer business which he still operated until his death.

Scotty was a devout Christian member of Whitefield Baptist Church. He loved his family, his many friends, his dog, Sooner, and his church family.

Scotty is survived by his mother, Fern Jones of the home; his sister, Shelly Seaton and husband Justin of Stigler; a niece, Kristin Clark of Stigler; numerous aunts, uncles and cousins.

He is preceded in death by his father, Dean Webster; his grandparents, Sib and Lorene Webster, and Henry and Estelle Duke.

Funeral services will be Monday, March 24, 2014, 10:00 A.M., Whitefield Baptist Church with Reverend Tommie Parker and Reverend Larry Harris officiating. Pallbearers include David Goins, Matt Webster, Stephen Webster, Johnny Bray, Kevin Gray, Michael Svenlid.
