Mr. Wayne Lynch, 64, longtime resident of Longtown died Tuesday, June 5, 2012 in a Tulsa hospital. He was born September 8, 1947 at Norman to Otis Lynch Sr. and Lucille (Helms) Lynch. He grew up in Oklahoma City where he received his education. He proudly served his country during the Viet Nam war with the United States Army. He was a Sergeant with the First Cavalry Division serving in the 10th infantry 3rd Battalion Charlie Company for two years from 1967 to 1969. After the war he was married to Wilma Lemley and made their home in Moore. He began a career with General Motors for many years until 1989. He made his home in Longtown in 1989 and worked for the McAlester Ammunition Depot for several years before his retirement.
