William Bolt (better known as Bill) received the ultimate healing when he entered the presence of God on Thursday, September 3, 2020. Bill had suffered a short illness but also endured several years of horrible disease known as Alzheimer's.

Bill was born in Williams, Oklahoma on July 18, 1933. He was one of six children, and the last surviving of Samuel and Susie Bolt. After having served in the U.S. Army during the Korean conflict, he married the love of his life, Marie Ary on July 9, 1959. They spent the first few years of their married life in Chula Vista, CA. where their first child, Jeffery was born in 1962. They then returned to Oklahoma and made their home for the next 50 years in Midwest City.

Bill spent nearly all his life as a Christian – devoted to loving and serving God as a strong husband, Father, and family man. He served in numerous churches throughout his life as a Sunday School teacher, deacon and church leader. He was the true example of being Christ-like. He truly walked the walk and talked the talk.

Bill retired from Tinker Air Force Base where he enjoyed his job as an NC machinist.
